

2025 Municipal Candidate How to Qualifying Guide

Verify Eligibility:

Residency: Ensure you have resided in the municipality or ward you intend to represent for at least two years prior to the general election date. Voter Registration: Confirm you are a registered voter in the respective municipality or ward.

Prepare Necessary Documents:

Statement of Intent: Complete the appropriate qualifying statement:

For party-affiliated candidates: "Qualifying Statement of Intent for a Candidate for Party Nomination."

For independent candidates: "Qualifying Statement of Intent for an Independent Candidate." **Qualifying Fee:** Prepare a \$10 fee, payable upon submission of your Statement of Intent. Petition Signatures (Independent Candidates Only): Collect signatures from at least 50 qualified electors within the municipality or ward.

Submit Qualifying Documents:

Where to Submit: File all documents with the Municipal Clerk's Office in your city of residence.

Deadline: Ensure submission by 5:00 p.m. on January 31, 2025. Late submissions will not be accepted.

File a Statement of Economic Interest:

Timeline: Submit this statement within 15 days of qualifying.

Where to File: File with the Mississippi Ethics Commission, located at 660 North Street, Suite #100-C, Jackson, MS 39202; Phone: (601) 359-1285.

Comply with Campaign Finance Disclosure:

Reporting: File required campaign finance disclosure reports with the Municipal Clerk's Office by the specified deadlines. All reports must be filled no later than 5:00 PM following deadline dates

Periodic Reports for Contributions and expenditures: - January 10, 2025 - March 25, 2025 - April 15, 2025 - May 27, 2025 - October 28, 2025 - November 25, 2025

Annual Report due: January 31, 2025, January 31, 2026

Prepare for the Election:

Primary Election: Scheduled for April 1, 2025. Primary Runoff (if necessary): April 22, 2025.

General Election: June 3, 2025.
